The actual number of stems in the several collections has not been much increased since the publication of Volume I, but the aggregate of finely conserved structure which is gradually being located and made available for study is great. Nordo the European collections fall behind those of America in interest. Although somewhat less extensive, their structural interest coequals that of the American collections. Easily the most noteworthy addition to the American series is the monocarpic trunk of the United States National Museum discovered by Dr. N. H. Darton in the Hermosa segment of the Black Hills Rim in certain respects the most remarkable fossil plant of any kind or age ever recovered. Fortunately, however, the study of the Cycadeoids has reached a point where progress is less dependent on rare or unusually conserved specimens. To this result the discovery of related Williamsonians has greatly contributed; equally so the...
