This language, which has been included in previous biennial funding resolutions, continues the practice of permitting the detail or assignment of personnel from departments or agencies of the government to the staff of a committee without reimbursement of that persons salary. The Committee on Rules and Administration intends that government employees, whose pay is disbursed by an agency of the Federal gov-ernment and who is detailed or assigned to a committee must com-ply with Rule 27, paragraph 4, of the Standing Rules of the Senate. In addition, S. Res. 77 (79th Congress, 1st Session) continues to apply to the use by a committee of assigned or detailed personnel on a reimbursement basis.
