




The RHS Pocket Address Book (Hardback)

After studying at the Royal College of Art, London, Lilian became a professional artist, contributing the illustrations to the supplements of Henry Elwes Monograph of the Genus Lilium. From 1916-21, she worked at the Royal Botanical Gardens, Edinburgh and in 1922 she became the principal illustrator of Curtis s Botanical Magazine and continued there until 1952. The RHS Pocket Address Book is illustrated in colour throughout and has a storage pocket on the inside back cover. Companion diary also available.
