The discourse is not dated; but Ramusio in his introduction says that it was written in the year 1539. - This Coast was discovered 15 years ago by Giovanna da Varrazzano who took possession of the same in the name of King Francis and of my Lady the Regent. That Country is called French Land by many, even by the Portugues themselves. The Regent was Louise de Savoie, the mother of Francis I., and this seems to account for the inscription both on the Maggiolo and Varrazano Maps. Luisa, named for the French king s mother, is an island off the south coast of New England, and Adrian Block, in 1614, laid it down on his chart. It is now known as Block Island. Mercator s map of the world gives the globe a flat surface, and by his system of projection in proportional parts...
