This rapidly became and has since remained the chief commercial centre. When a small force of the North-west Mounted Police was first sent into the Yukon District in 1895, in the interests of law and order, it was quartered near Forty-mile River. Later on, this force increased and the circumstances led to the removal of most of the men to Dawson. This place has since become the seat of government for the entire Yukon District. A local administration, with courts of justice and other organizations necessary for the government of the Yukon district have been established, and the city is now not unprovided with most of the requirements of a civilized and progressive community. This report relates almost exclusively to the Klondike gold fields proper.
