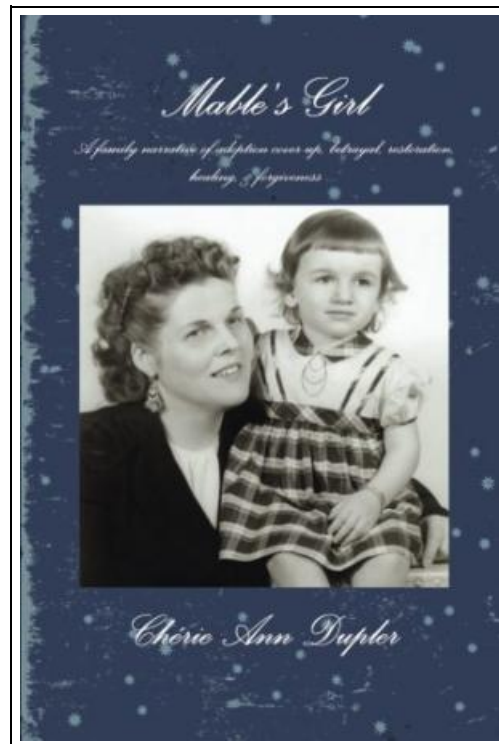

Grandpa (Putter), a philanderer who also drank too much, brought much heartache to his family, especially to Grandma (Mae). The duty to raise their children fell exclusively to her. Though she had an occasional unpleasant encounter with her husband's lovers at work, the time in which they lived precluded divorce as a viable option, so Grandma had to stay married and be the breadwinner. Mable was the youngest of their six children and watched her mother's pain over her father's actions. Over the years she formed strong opinions about men due to his negative influence as a role model. Mable and her sister Rene entered the workforce at a factory during an explosive time in history, the late thirties, when union violence posed a real threat. Despite some hardships, their story is one of surviving well during the depression. In part because of her father's negative influence, Mable decided to become pregnant on purpose out of wedlock and raise that child on her own, in defiance of the societal norms of her time. Cheris, (Mable's daughter), story begins there. In her fifties, she found out from her 89-year-old aunt, (Rene), that the man she thought was her father had adopted her. It shook her world. The rest of the book focuses on Cheris' innocent baby boomer childhood, the simplicity of the fifties, the turbulent sixties, and the many societal changes during that time. Yet through it all, this family maintained its uniqueness and sense of continuity. Cheri recounts her own marriage and divorce, five children, (the fourth pregnancy was fraternal twin boys), and how she not only survived but thrived. Through tears and joys they...
