The author looks at three important questions every Christian must consider when studying what the Bible teaches about the end-times: Are we living in the last days? Should we try to predict the time of Christ's return? What must all Christians believe about the last days? He offers a side-by-side comparison of the positions popular among evangelicals, followed by an exegesis of the relevant biblical passages, & an explanation of his own conclusions. Contains a helpful glossary & bibliography. Lewis tries hard to be evenhanded in his exposition & for the most part succeeds. He offers much sane, balanced, biblical advice about these controversial issues. When treating the various interpretations of the Millennium, however, his personal prejudices become evident: he devotes significant space to criticizing dispensational premillennialism, not always fairly, while his own position, which is apparently covenant (or "historic") premillennialism, is simply presented positively without any critique. Nevertheless, if allowance is made for the author's personal bias, his book is well worth reading.
