While it was occasionally done in the earlier days of the Cavalry Association, it has not been customary to notice in the Cavalry Journal the death of any of its members however, distinguished they have been as cavalry soldiers. Yet it is deemed eminently proper to take such action in the case of the late Brigadier General Camillo C. C. Carr, who died at Chicago on July 24th last. For the nearly thirty years of the life of the U. S. Cavalry Association, General Carr was one of its staunchest supporters, in addition to having been one of its original organizers and for many years an officer of the Association. He was the Chairman of the Commitee that drafted the first Constitution and also of the one that, a few years later, revised the same, which revised Constitution is practically the same as the one now in force. He was for several years the VicePresident of the Association, while General Merritt was its President, and he was a member of the Executive Council during the entire time that he served at Fort Leavenworth, after the Association was organized. He served as Editor of the CavAlry Journal from June 1890 to September, 1892. General Carr was a soldier in the Army of the United States for nearly fifty-two years, during which time he served in every grade of the cavalry service from private to general officer with honor and distinction.
