However, the contrary is actually the case, due to the modern developments of methods of warfare, and more especially due to the peculiar conditions of the problem of our defense. The functions of navy and army are interdependent and correlated. To be sure, the maintenance of the command of the sea is purely a function of the navy, as field operations are likewise functions of the army. Between the two is the coast defense, including the coast patrol, coast-guard service, the communication by wireless between sea and shore, and combined operations involving the transport of troops by sea. In such cases the regulations of both army and navy vaguely require cooperation, without defining what this cooperation shall be. In general, it is left to the commanders, and the resulting cooperation is largely dependent upon their personal and official relations. Should both be tactful, they may attain a compromise that will produce the desired results. Should they fail to agree, and, as they are human, it is only natural that such should often be the case, coordination of effort cannot be hoped...
