Shown in the light spaces. These dots are not shown, you will see, in the outer spaces where the hexagonal fields, as well as the appearance of inter-spaces are quite clear. Now there is a very curious fact in this connection which I ask you to observe. Photographs of transverse sections of enamel rods in critical focus show a dotted appearance very similar to the secondary markings on this diatom. These dots I have described as representing the transverse sections of calcified plasmic strings as shown in the ameloblasts, but Dr. Walkhoff says that the enamel prism is grainless or structureless, precisely as the outer or out-of-focus region of spaces in the Tricelarium appear to be. I therefore conclude that Dr. Walkhoff, notwithstanding his theoretically critical attitude, has not succeeded in getting a critical field of vision in his microscope. I shall make this point plainer to you presently....
