She meditates on the life of her pioneering grandparents, and at the same time worries about the world her grandchildren will inherit. In a slow, measured voice with flashes of wit and humour, Munk considers her universe remembering, imagining, observing, recording, never losing sight of the beauty and mystery that surround her. Barbara Munk s mother was one of the Huble girls, members of a distinguished northern BC pioneer family, and her father, Tom Corless, was a pioneering bush pilot. Born in 1935, Munk herself is a pioneer in that she was one of the first women of the North to leave home to attend...
