




Gargantua and Pantagruel [Christmas Summary Classics]

Brought up in a Franciscan convent, he was made a priest in 1520. He then studied medicine, and became a physician. After wandering about France for many years, he was appointed parish priest of Meudon in 1551, and he died at Paris in 1553. The Great and Inestimable Chronicles of the Grand and Enormous Giant Gargantua (Les Grandes et Inestimables Chroniques du Grande et Enorme Geant Gargantua), and its sequel, Pantagruel, appeared between 1533 and 1564.
