Geospatial Information Systems (GIS) are a type of CIMS. GIS have been underutilized by the military which traditionally uses geographic data as cartographic and imagery support for military intelligence and maneuver purposes. This monograph provides a framework for determining the value of using GIS as a tool in counterinsurgency (COIN). Given the crucial role that geography plays in the Colombian internal conflict, this case presents a unique opportunity to evaluate the capabilities that GIS offer. Recent experience shows that, despite achieving a significant measure of success on the battlefield, the Armed Forces of the United States of America face continuing challenges in adapting to the requirements of a long term global struggle. The nature of the current conflict or Long War requires effective engagement, coordination, and collaboration with interagency and international partners.
