The reports are based on findings from the Study on School Violence and Prevention, which investigated the extent of problem behavior in 886 schools across the U. S. The findings indicate that schools . in general were safe, but certain schools had significant problems that affected instruction and made some teachers and students feel unsafe. The higher rates of discipline problems in middle schools suggest that greater attention to prevention efforts in middle school may be warranted. School should focus on improving prevention activities by strengthening efforts to adopt, retain, or discard prevention efforts based on evidence of program effectiveness. While fighting did occur and the presence of weapons was not unheard of, the combination of the two was rarely seen in the same school. Theft was much more common than robbery, and while teachers may have been verbally abused, they rarely were attacked or threatened with a weapon. The fear of disorder did not seem to interfere with learning. Schools followed similar discipline...
