In laying this work before the New Shakspeare Society I wish it to be distinctly understood that I claim no credit for originality either of plan or execution. The plan was suggested by Mr James Spedding, the Editor of Bacons Works; and at Mr Furnivalls instance I undertook the work, which had indeed been already carried out, for German students, by Professor Tycho Mommsen in his parallel-text edition of the first two quartos of this play, published at Oldenburgh, in 1859. For the execution of it I am mainly indebted to the thorough and independent collations of the early texts contained in Professor Mommsens book, and in the Cambridge Shakespeare edited by Messrs W. G. Clark and W. Aldis Wright. Without the assistance afforded me by these important works I could not, or certainly would not, have engaged in this task; with it I have been enabled to compile a work which I believe will be found to be useful to the Shaksperian student.
