It will be observed that both clocks were accelerated at the 15t ; this was chiefly caused by a fall of the barometer of three-fourths of an inch (Memoirs Ast. Soc., vol. v. p. 125). The mercurial pendulum of my clock is accelerated 0 . 37 by a fall of one inch; the coefficient for the gridiron pendulum which belongs to the Dublin clock is probably greater, but as the effect is only differential, it seemed unnecessary to allow for it.
