Stress is laid, in the preparation of manuscripts, upon brevity, accuracy and clearness, and adherence to the accepted forms of present day usage. One of the greatest values of the book is the inclusion of certain material difficult to find elsewhere, at least in so convenient and compact a form. Among this material are useful lists, such as those of words still italicized and of words no longer italicized, English plurals of Latin or foreign terms, words still retaining...
