A sensual and intellectual feast, Sometimes a Great Notion is a deconstruction of the contemporary artist s life; it s also a tough, compassionate look at the future of the future and our philosophy of love. Culinary adventures and geography juxtapose with Japanese culture, erotic interludes are interrupted by notes on Alex Colville, giving us the clearest picture of convergence theory we ve had since Marshall McLuhan was a young man. Here, in poems like Luce or Pillows, Donnell pushes the boundaries of minimalism in original and subtle ways and succeeds like peach ice cream on a hot day. Moment after moment, this is a provocative and refreshing book.
