

During the year ending September 1, 1907, only about a fourth as much reading matter appeared from this press as appeared last year, or 426 pages of line type as against 1,768 pages of Braille; and, whereas in the former year but three new books were published, in the latter there were 36. These 36 were chiefly short stories chosen for the general reader. Editions of fifty were bound up. Twelve or more copies were placed in our library, and the fact immediately published in the periodical magazines for the blind that they could be borrowed for the asking by anyone anywhere.
