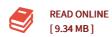

Excerpt from Annual Catalogue for 1881: Containing a List of Garden, Field and Flower Seeds, Together With Prices and Cultural Directions Green-house seeds should be sewn in pots or pans half full of drainage (broken charcoal preferable); cover this with rough siftings of mould and the surface with fine soil and silver sand, and moisten, using a fine rose. Sow seed evenly over the surface, cover very lightly, keeping from the rays of the sun until the plants show the third leaf, then transplant into seed pans three-fourths of an inch apart, keeping them under a frame until perfectly recovered, giving a little air to strengthen them. As soon as they begin to touch each other transplant into small pots and keep in a cool, airy part of the green-house near the glass, repotting them when necessary. Soil. - The preparation of the soil, especially for sowing the smaller kinds of seeds, is of the greatest importance, the success or failure of the crop depending largely upon it.
