Invisible, as the title suggests, is an exploration of things unseen, formerly seen, and then seen again through the powers of memory and imagination. The word turns, like a wheel (literally) throughout the book (paperback version only). In a series of very loosely related poems and a potpourri of aphorisms, the reader is guided on a journey through a variety of strained, failed, and sometimes humorous personal relationships; imaginary wars between poetry and prose, and the absolute necessity of love and kindness. The hum throughout the work is the Donohue's voice reflecting on our unrelenting experience of getting older and heading towards eternal invisibility. This ever changing, ever turning wheel of the invisible spins through the book's aphorisms as well, but it does so in surprising ways and topics, like clothes: I'm grateful for clothes. Without them, nakedness would just mean nothing, and balls, that are hit so hard they disappear and land in another sport. The idea of approaching death appears and disappears in this volume, until Donohue confronts it head on, in one of the last poems in...
