

This series of short incisive books introduces major figures of the ancient world to the modern general reader, including the essentials of each subject s life, works, and significance for later western civilisation. In the newly created tradition of the Ancients in Action series, Marguerite Johnson has written a fascinating and accessible account of what remains of the life and works of the Greek poet, Sappho. Sappho s ancient biography is covered in addition to the post-classical accounts of her life, which continue to appear, in a variety of creative and noncreative contexts, in contemporary literature and art. Sappho s poetry, essentially preserved in tantalising fragments, is discussed in a series of thematic chapters that include her religious writings, particularly directed to the goddess of love, Aphrodite; personal interpretations of mythological themes; marriage hymns; and love songs to female companions.
