In the summer of 1903 I spent some time at the Minnesota Seaside Station at Port Renfrew on the West Coast of Vancouver Island at the entrance of the Strait of Juan de Fuca. There was no provision made for dredging, consequently all the specimens obtained were shore forms. In 1908 and again in 1909 I spent some time at the Dominion Biological Station at Departure Bay, five miles from the City of Nanaimo on the East Coast of the Island. Here I collected shore specimens and obtained others by dredging, seldom in water more than 25 fathoms deep. The best locality for dredging was in Northumberland Strait, between Gabriola Island and other smaller Islands, at the mouth of Dodd s Narrows, a narrow channel between two small islands, about ten miles southeast of...
