Excerpt from The Fats and Oils Situation: September 1947 Production of animal fats is likely to be somewhat smaller in 1947-48 than season just ending, partly as a result of the relatively small corn crop 11. On September 1, corn production was forecast at billion bushels, not less than in 1946. With less corn, hogs and cattle probably will be marketed earlier and at lighter weights than in 1946-47. Consequently less animal slaughtered probably will be recovered. The decline in lard and yields per hog probably will more than offset the slight increase expected number of hogs to be slaughtered. Cattle slaughter may be slightly less in the beginning of October 1947, since the number of cattle on farms has been considerably reduced by heavy slaughter during the past 12 months.
