Excerpt from Foreign Crops and Markets, Vol. 6: April 25, 1923 The Italian Government recently called representatives of sugar - beet growers and manufacturers to Rome to form a new agreement between the growers and manufacturers. In the past the production has been dependent upon contracts according to which the growers sold their beets to the sugar planters at a price fixed each year prior to the planting. This system encouraged the grower to raise a large crop of beets. It usually cost 3rd to their sugar value and consequently cultivation was extended to land where beets would grow regardless of its suitability. Under the new form of agreement the growers sell the sugar contained in their beets at the price it will bring in the market and not at a preestablished price. The consequence of this is expected to be that the farmers with careful selection of land and with proper methods of cultivation, will produce beets richer in sugar, in consequence of...
