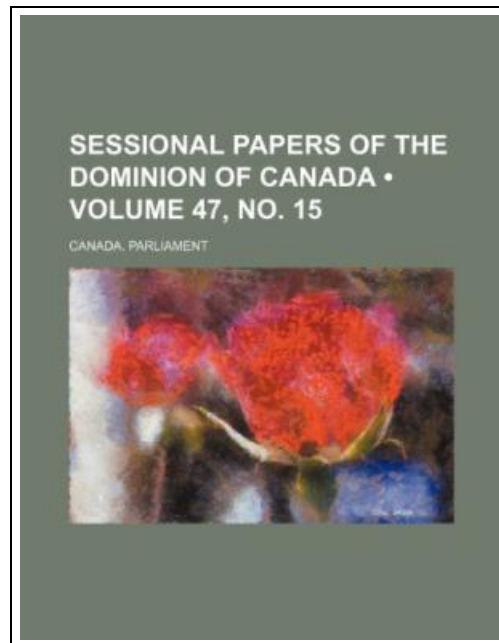

The Inland Revenue employees, especially accountants, book-keepers, officers in charge of manufactories require special qualifications, the acquisition of which entails considerable study and expense upon them. That for a large number it is utterly impossible for them to live on their present, salaries, and provide the bare necessities of life for their families. Your petitioners would therefore pray that you kindly report in favour of an increase of salary in proportion to or based on the present high cost of living; and that said increase be granted immediately instead of, by the small annual increments of five per cent usually allowed. If the Government will grant this request, it will relieve the straightened circumstances to which many have been reduced under the present system. And your petitioners will ever pray. (Signed).
